Spanish Podcast (Review or Jump-start)

The first assignment will be to create a podcast in which you will introduce and tell about yourself and one other person. The person can be a celebrity, a family member, or a friend.

Other Person:

Try to pick someone that you know a lot about.

If there is some fact about them that you do not know, you can either look it up or make a reasonable assumption.

Rough Draft/Final Draft:

Rough drafts must be completed before you will get on the computers. You may be given an alternate assignment if it appears that you will not have time to finish. I will look over rough drafts and make corrections. Final drafts must be checked by the teacher before you record your voice.

Voice Recording:

You will have to record your voice in very small segments in order to get through it. Recording in Spanish will be much more difficult than any podcasting you have done in English. We will work on Spanish pronunciation basics but you will still have to practice speaking your podcast many times. You will probably end up recording and re-recording several times in order for your podcast to be clear and intelligible.

Pictures:

You must include a picture for each piece of information that you include. You must have URLs for each picture. *Pictures must be appropriate for school.*

Music:

You can add music if everything else is complete and your voice recording is approved by the teacher.
